The Challenge

LGBTI youth face persistent discrimination and barriers to employment:

- Bullying at school
- I ow self-esteem and motivation.
- Fear of harassment in educational institutions or at work
- Underutilization of youth employment programs



Our Innovative Approach

- 1. Adapting existing youth employment services for LGBTI youth
- **2. Individual empowerment** through personalized career development plans
- **3. Practical skill building in the workplace** at LGBTI-inclusive companies
- **4. Creating a support network** between the LGBTI community and inclusive employers

Key Activities

- Personal career counselling: for 120 LGBTI NEETs
- Mock job interviews and training with professional HR specialists
- Special events to attract LGBTI-inclusive employers
- Skills validation practices and internship opportunities
- Career fairs to strengthen connections and competencies
